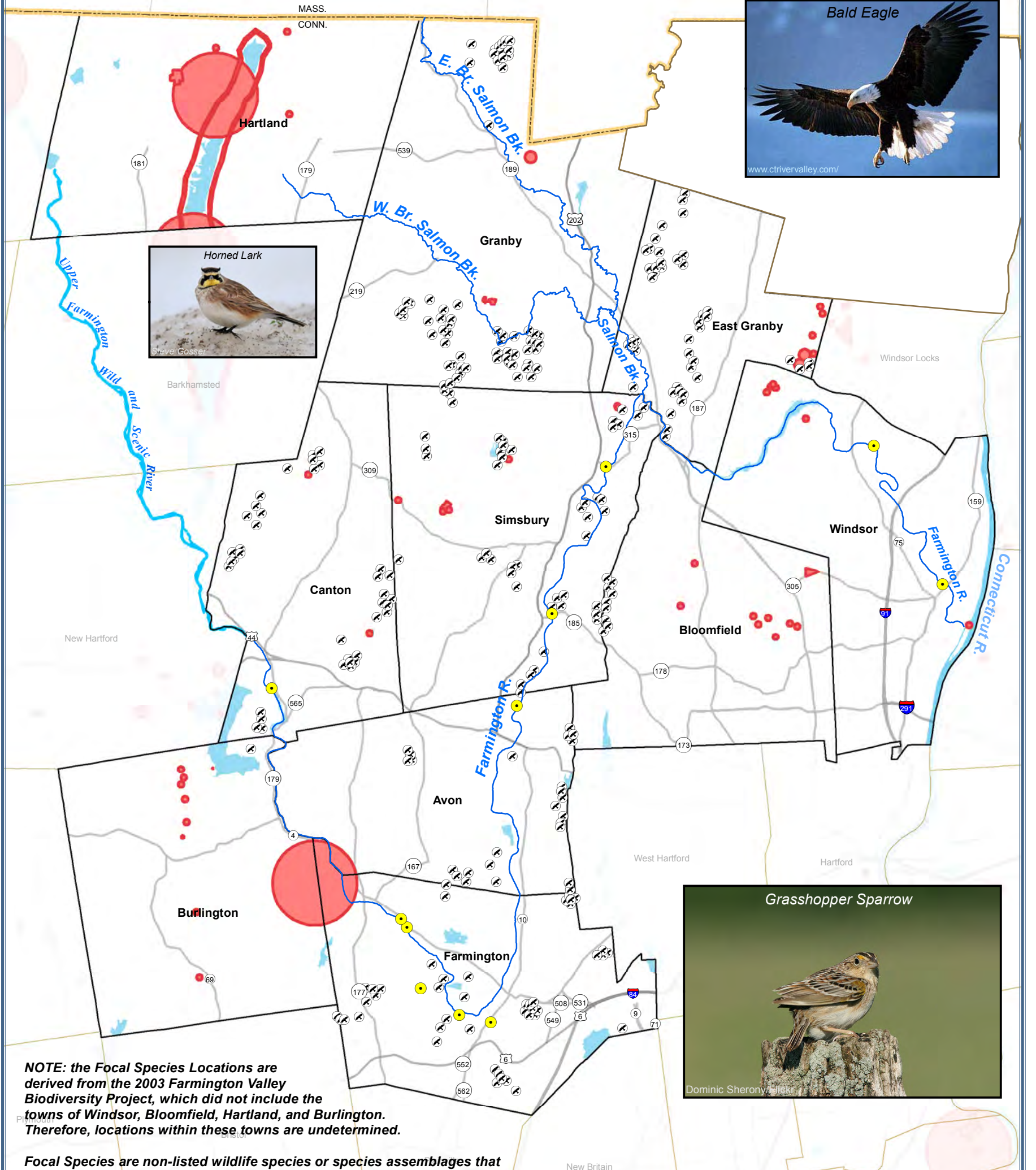

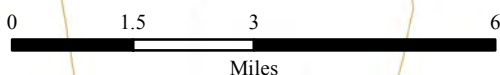


**NOTE:** the Focal Species Locations are derived from the 2003 Farmington Valley Biodiversity Project, which did not include the towns of Windsor, Bloomfield, Hartland, and Burlington. Therefore, locations within these towns are undetermined.

**Focal Species** are non-listed wildlife species or species assemblages that are recognized as being of conservation concern. These species are under-going non-cyclical, long-term population declines throughout the northeast and are vulnerable to land use practices that result in habitat loss and fragmentation.
